Digital images should be sRGB, 72 ppi, 1024 pixels for a horizontal image, 768 pixels tall for a vertical image.

Charter Changes Notice

At the April meeting of the Board of Directors we proposed the following changes to our Charter. The change in item 3 will align our election of officers with our actual physical year. The change in item 4 will allow for a smoother transition of elected officials. Please read the changes and if you have any comments, please email **harvey@kopel.us** or **eileendura@mac.com**. These proposals will be voted on at our June meeting.

Proposed changes:

- 3. Governance of the Committee is by an executive board of eight Committee members nominated from the membership in May and elected by the membership at the June meeting. To assist in this process the Board may appoint an ad hoc nominating Committee. Board members may not serve more than four one-year terms, consecutively.
- 4. As soon as possible after its election, the Executive Board shall elect one of its members as Chairperson and another as Chairperson Elect by a majority vote. The Chairperson Elect will be in line to replace the Chairperson, shall he/she resign, be term-limited off the board, or otherwise leave office. If the current Chairperson is term-limited out of office he/she will remain on the Executive Board for one year as a ninth member, but be a nonvoting member. The Chairperson shall appoint members of the board and/or other Committee members to assist in performing the functions of the Committee.
